



I-795 at Dolfield Boulevard Interchange Project

Public Open House to Present New Design Planned for May 1

The Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) invites you to attend a public open house for the I-795 at Dolfield Boulevard Interchange Project in Owings Mills, Baltimore County. The project team has refined the original design from 2015 and is seeking public input.

Project Overview

The purpose of the project is to improve access to the commercial growth planned along Red Run Boulevard. The project team seeks to improve pedestrian, bicycle and vehicular, accommodations along Dolfield Boulevard; and provide safety and capacity improvements along I-795. The revised design minimizes impacts and improves safety, traffic operations, and access to local roadways. The project is funded for design and is expected to reach the 65 percent design completion milestone by early 2025.

The scope of the project includes:

- A third through lane in each direction of I-795 from Franklin Boulevard to MD 940 (2.5 miles),
- New interchange access points around Dolfield Boulevard, including:
 - A northbound I-795 off-ramp to a new roundabout at Tollgate Road and Hewitt Farms Road,
 - A northbound I-795 on-ramp connecting Dolfield Boulevard to I-795,
 - Southbound I-795 on and off ramps connecting to Red Run Boulevard,
- Pedestrian and bicycle accommodations,
- Drainage and stormwater management improvements, and
- Landscape enhancements.

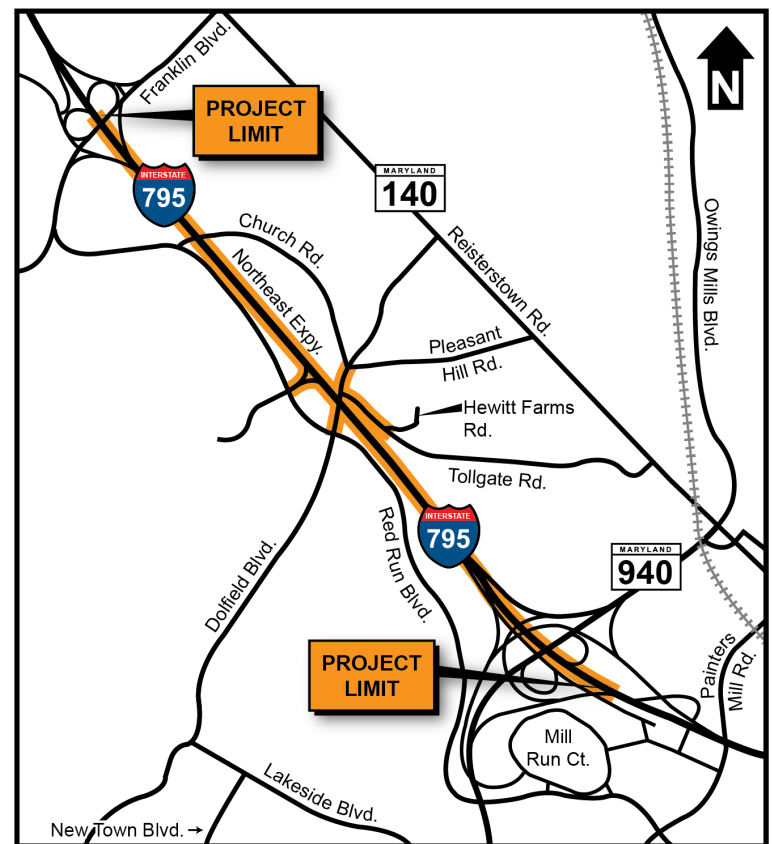

You are Invited to Attend a Public Open House

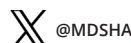
The State Highway Administration will hold a public open house on Wednesday, May 1, 2024, from 5 - 7 p.m. at New Town High School.
